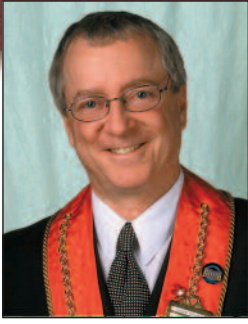


# Note from the Bailli Délégué
